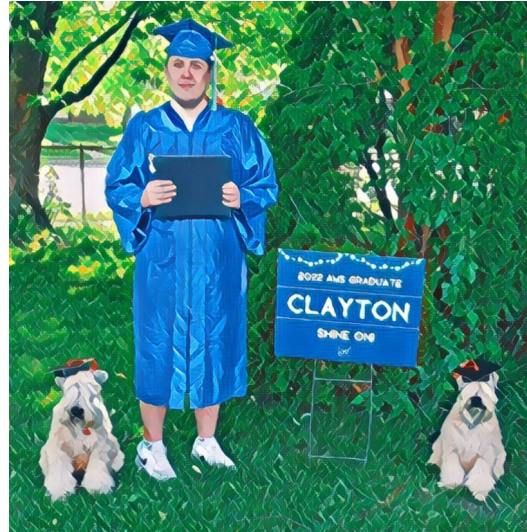
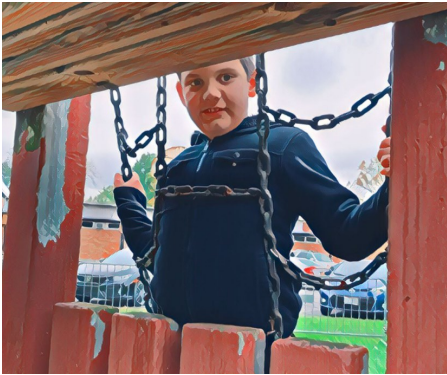


AUTISM MODEL SCHOOL

As a publicly funded community school in Ohio we provide **tuition-free** services.

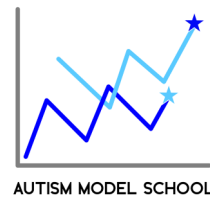


There is currently a **waiting list** for students to attend the Autism Model School.

ABOUT US

The Autism Model School is a public community school serving students ages 5 to 22.



We were started in 1998 by a group of nine parents who each had a child with autism.

The school, in partnership with parents and the community, will provide a **nurturing environment** and develop the **full potential** of differently-abled students within the Autism Spectrum Disorders using a **multidisciplinary approach** addressing individual needs.

We **believe**...

- The only appropriate education is an effective education
- Parental involvement and participation is crucial in a child's development
- Programming should be accountable for creating socially valuable, functional, and acceptable outcomes
- A working relationship between school and home is critical to the success of a child's education
- If the child cannot learn by the way we teach, then we must teach in a way the child can learn
- Behavior in any form is communication
- Everyone belongs

We accept **applications** for students in grades K-12 based on submission of the following...

(1) Student Application

Print online at amstoledo.org/family/admission or request a hard copy from our main office.

(2) Academic Documentation

To provide the appropriate classroom placement we ask for the following documents...

- Individualized Education Plan (IEP or 504)
- Evaluation Team Report (ETR) or Multi-factored Evaluation (MFE)
- Other student evaluations, assessments or reports

(3) Age and Residency

A student must be between the ages of 5-21 and a legal resident of the state of Ohio.

Additional documents we'll need include...

- Copy of birth certificate
- Copy of utility bill or lease agreement
- Notarized affidavit of current address
- Immunization records or an exemption form
