At Autism Model School, we are always measuring success!

As part of the requirements for earning her Master's degree in Applied Behavior Analysis from Western Michigan University, Ally Miller<sup>1</sup> completed a formal study of the teaching procedures used to support students in the Aut-To-Be Partners job training program.

Guess what she found?

Just like our students, the results were amazing!

All participants in the study learned to use activity schedules to independently complete three different Aut-To-Be Partners jobs targeted for training.

Jobs trained as part of Ally's study included the following:

<b>Job 1</b>	Count and sort products for an order
<b>Job 2</b>	Package the products
<b>Job 3</b>	Measure and weight the package for shipping

Ally also evaluated the number of training sessions that each student required to reach full independence with each job.

Guess what?!

More amazing results!

Every participant learned newly introduced jobs in fewer training sessions than the previously trained job.

Our amazing students were becoming "quick learners" as a result of their participation in the Aut-To-Be Partners program!!!
